High interest/low reading level books

For our UKS2 children who are still finding reading difficult, we have a selection of high interest/low reading level books on topics that their peers are reading, but targeted toward their reading level.

High/low books can help build reading fluency, vocabulary, background knowledge and interest in reading.

Effective high/low books provide supports for struggling readers, including illustrations to support the text, carefully chosen vocabulary, simple sentences, compelling stories, and characters that interest the reader.

The very best high/low books materials provide these supports invisibly, so that young readers don't feel that they are reading "books for babies."

It is the responsibility of the class teacher to ensure that these books are read in sequence. In addition, these children should be heard to read at least once a week by their class teacher. All comments must be recorded in the class reading folder and in pupil home/school reading records.
