Geography offers the opportunity to study a range of topics that investigate the physical processes of our planet, human societies and the economic and environmental challenges within the local, national and global context. This gives students the confidence to interact with the wider world, leading to fulfilled and positive life experiences. The curriculum encourages pupils to ask questions, develop critical thinking skills, and layer a deeper understanding of complex concepts as they progress through their learning journey.

Geographical knowledge and skills are embedded within units of work throughout all year groups, including EYFS. Fieldwork enquiries enable students to apply their skills, knowledge and understanding within both human and physical geography.
